



He teaches in the Strategic Leadership Development and Directors Education Programs. Dr. Radford has won several awards for teaching including the Students Union Excellence in Teaching award, the Commerce Undergraduate Society Award for Outstanding Teaching and Learning and the University of Calgary Teaching Award.

Prior to joining academe, Scott was Director of Advertising for R. Nicholls Distributors, and Director of Marketing for Collins Safety.

He currently serves on the Boards of the University of Calgary Properties Group, the Canadian association of Snowboard Instructors, and Mount Allen Ski Team.

Heavily involved in Canada's legal and queer communities, Jonathan serves as a member of the Canadian Bar Association's Ethics and Professional Responsibility sub-committee; a Director of the Canadian Association of LGBTQ+Lawyers (CALL); and a member of the Federation of Law Societies Model Code Liaison Committee. Recently, Jonathan served as an executive, officer and then the Chair of the Canadian Bar Association's National Sexual and Gender Diversity Alliance Section (SAGDA).

Step 1:


Gondola Base

Your adventure starts here. Fuel up with a coffee from Starbucks, satisfy your sweet tooth with a treat from the candy store or pick-out that perfect memento to bring home from the gift shop.

Step 2:

Banff Gondola Ride

Soar 698 metres (2,292 feet) on an 8-minute journey to the summit of Sulphur Mountain. Glide over the treetops and arrive at a jaw-dropping mountaintop experience.

Step 3:

Banff Gondola Summit

There's no shortage of fun in our state-of-the-art summit building. With interactive interpretive exhibits, and a breathtaking 360-degree rooftop observation deck, the Banff Gondola summit heightens every sense.

With six stunning mountain ranges and the sweep of the Bow Valley before you, views from the Sulphur Mountain summit are nothing short of breathtaking.

Step 4

Sulphur Mountain Boardwalk

Several scenic hiking trails lead away from the summit complex. One of the most popular is the selfguided interpretive Sulphur Mountain Boardwalk to Sanson's Peak. More adventurous hikers will want to try the South East Ridge Trail — a route that runs along the ridge of the mountain to the south, taking you to Sulphur Mountain's true summit.
